Manjeet Uppal provided a verbal update on behalf of Ashleigh Martinflatt.

Highlights include:

- a donation from Island Savings;
- successful professional development event that included staff from organizations within the Harewood community;
- eight students working on their practicums in the Centre, with guidance from Teri Derksen.

Projects in the community include:

- an eight week program about setting future goals, called I Have A Dream;
- the Healthy Kids program offered by the Child and Youth Care and Dental Hygiene programs, where students visit elementary schools in Harewood to teach healthy oral care habits;
- programs such as Friday Night Light, Will You be my Neighbour, Georgia Avenue Spring Fair and Youth Drop-in, that run at the Georgia Avenue school;
- a mental health and wellness initiative involving grade 6 and 7 students that will investigate social justice issues and awareness.
